

## Blindfold Watergun Hunt

*Illustration:* Divide your students into two groups and choose a volunteer from each. Blindfold your volunteers and then hide a watergun for each somewhere in the room, an equal distance from each volunteer. Each group of students, by yelling out directions, is supposed to help guide their volunteer to a watergun. When he finds it, he can take off the blindfold and squirt the other seeker three times. This is a great illustration to play, to tie in a point and then to play it again and tie in other applications.

*Spiritual Application:* God loves you so much He'll never leave you "blind". He tells you how you can have real life, by giving your life to Jesus and following Him. This is also a great illustration to kick-off a discussion of any of the "blind man" stories in the Bibles—i.e., "How did it feel to be blind? What do you think it would be like to be blind from birth? Listen this story about a blind man and Jesus..."
