

Easter Egg Emptiness

Show your students two plastic Easter eggs of the same color—one with candy and one without. Say, “These eggs look the same but there is something very different about them. Even though they look the same on the outside, one is empty and the other is filled with something good. In the same way, two people may look the same, but someone who doesn’t have Jesus as their Savior is going to be empty on the inside. But someone who knows Jesus has something great—something worth living for, dying for and sharing with your friends. (Read and discuss Matthew 13:44-45).
