Easter Egg Relay

Set out two bowls with four plastic eggs in each. One of the bowls should have eggs that contain candy. The other bowl's eggs are empty. Call up four volunteers, two boys and two girls. This is a girl vs. boy competition. Have the boys line up behind an empty bowl on the opposite side of the room from the bowls with eggs. Have the girls line up behind another empty bowl. When you say go, the first person in line races to their line's bowl of eggs, grabs one and races back to put it in the empty bowl. Then the second person takes a turn. Each person will have two turns. When the game is finished, congratulate both teams on a good job.

Spiritual Application: Show two eggs of the same color from different bowls—one with candy and one without. Say, "These eggs look the same but there is something very different about them. Even though they look the same on the outside, one is empty and the other is filled with something good. In the same way, two people may look the same, but someone who doesn't have Jesus as their Savior is going to be empty on the inside. But someone who knows Jesus has something great. If you know Jesus, just like they took the eggs from one place to another, you can take Jesus to those who don't know Him and tell them about how Jesus lived a perfect life and how He died, rose again and (showing an empty egg) left an empty tomb. He left the tomb empty so that you wouldn't be—your life can be filled with all the good things of God.
