Making Hearts

When students arrive, give each of them a red piece of paper and some kid scissors (NOTE: Younger children will need help with this.) Ask them and show them how to cut out a heart. Then on the hearts ask them to write five ways that they can show love for other people. (Ask the younger children to draw a picture of someone doing something that shows love. Then ask them to explain what their picture is about.)

SAY: God always wants us to show love for others but loving people isn't always easy.

Ask the students-Does God want you to love people who are like you?

<u>Ask the students</u>—Does God want you to love other people who are different from you?

<u>Ask the students</u>—Does God want you to love people of other races?

<u>Ask the students</u>—Does God want you to love people who are poor...or needy...or dirty...or mean...or rich...or smelly?

<u>Ask the students</u>—Does God want you to love people who have other religions and don't believe in Jesus?

SAY: God loves everyone and wants you to love everyone as well.

REPEAT after me: God wants me to love everyone!
