Since there are four words, you will eventually choose two volunteers from each team.

Once all the words have been guessed, ask where they think the words go in the sentence. Eventually they will come up with: Romans 5:8 "But God showed his love for us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

Ask the Kids—How does God show his love for us? Who can tell me what a sinner is?
