Characters needed: Father and 1 or 2 daughters

Daughter: Hey, dad, why do we have Mother's Day?

Father: Well, (daughter's name), it's to show moms that we appreciate them for

all they do.

Daughter: Like what?

Father: Well just think about it. Who does most of the laundry around the house?

Daughter: Mom does.

Father: Who cleans the toilets in our house?

Daughter: Mom does.

Father: And who takes care of you most of the time when you're sick?

Daughter: Mom does.

Father: And there's a lot of other nice things that moms do.

Daughter 1: Yeah, mom is always picking up your dirty socks when you leave them on the floor. And she picks up your cups when you leave them by the chair. And she never complains about your snoring--even though she has to sleep in the same room with you.

Father: Okay. Okay. I think you get the picture. You know God gave us moms to help take care of us, but even the world's greatest mom can't begin to compare with how God takes care of us.
