

On-and-Off Goodness

Have two funny hats ready, one to represent being good and the other to represent being bad. Choose a volunteer. Put the good hat on his head and say, "Some people are good at church." Put the bad hat on and say, "But when they go to school, they do bad things." Put the good hat on and say, "But when they are at home, they act great." Put the bad hat on and say, "But at grandma's house, they act terrible."

Spiritual Application: What the problem here? They act good in some places and times and bad at other. They have on-and-off goodness. God doesn't want you to have on-and-off goodness. Instead, He wants you to follow Jesus—everywhere, every moment of every day—at home, at school, at grandma's house, at church, in Wal-mart...everywhere.
