

# Prayer Skit

Use the following skit to teach about some obstacles that some students face concerning prayer:

*All three illustrations are pictures of two people in conversation. After each one someone needs to ask, "So what's wrong with their relationship?"*

Part 1—Two people are standing together but one of them just keeps repeating the same thing over and over again.. Have one of your skit-persons say "Rats, I hate rats. They drive me crazy. Crazy, I was crazy once. They locked me in a room; a rubber room, a rubber room with rats. " Just keep repeating the same thing over and over.

*Spiritual Application: "So what's wrong with their relationship?"* He just keeps repeating the same thing over and over. Some people are like this when they pray. They just say the same thing over and over again

Part 2— The same two people are standing together but only one does all the talking. Have one of your skit-persons talk non-stop for about a minute about the mall and clothes, etc.

*Spiritual Application: "So what's wrong with their relationship?"* Only one person is talking. Most people are like this when they pray. They are talking so much, they rarely take time to listen.

Part 3—The two characters just stand there looking around. Nobody says a word.

*Spiritual Application: "So what's wrong with their relationship?"* They're not talking. Likewise, one of people's greatest downfalls when praying is that most people just don't do it.
