The New Mexico Tour

This past month we shared in Cloudcroft, Silver City, Gila, Bloomfield, and Aztec in New Mexico and in Burkburnett, TX as well. It was great to see how the Lord moved and to learn how to be more effective in New Mexico when we return in the spring of 2020. During this trip, **we saw children, youth and**

adults all make decisions for Christ.

In northwestern New Mexico, a family showed up about an hour early. I had shared at the junior high earlier that morning and the son had asked his family to come. They are Native American and live on a nearby reservation. At the end of the service, the mom approached one of the staff members and said, "I'm trying to understand why Jesus is so important. You worship Him. People celebrate Him at Christmas but I just don't understand who He is." They talked for a bit and made an appointment to talk more because it was like sharing Jesus with someone on the mission field who has never heard of Him before. Plus the mom wanted others in her family to come and hear as well. A couple of days after we left, they sent me the following text, "**Cynthia, her husband, mother and 4 of her 6 children accepted Christ!** Her sisters were not able to come to the meeting but they are definitely seeking."

In southern New Mexico last month, a number of children and youth came to hear the Gospel. A mom came up to the pastor's wife and said, "Is it okay if I just drop off my daughter? I don't want to stay. Church really isn't for me." The pastor's wife said that it was fine and told her when the activities would be over. The mom said she might stay around for a few minutes since we were getting ready to start but that she'd come back when everything ended. She sat at the very back of the room but stayed for the entire service. At the end she went up the pastor's wife and handed her eleven dollars that was all crumpled up and asked her to give it to us and to tell us thank you. I'm not sure why she did this except that the Lord touched her heart. She said that **she had never heard anyone talk about Jesus that way before**. Please pray for her, that she will come to Christ.

There were 3 occasions in New Mexico when we had **more than twenty people respond during the invitation**. On one night my sons and I led 7 people to Christ. I'm not sure how many others came to the Lord that night with the five other leaders who helped us during decision time.

On a Sunday morning, a 54-year old man came forward to his pastor and said, "I'm not sure I have eternal life." That morning, he accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior.

Just last week, we had the opportunity to share with over 2,500 people. On Wednesday, we shared at a high school doing an assemblies on "Life Choices." That night a 17-year old young lady **walked 15 minutes in the rain to come to the evening outreach**. I sat and talked with her and she told me that she came because at school I had said that I was going to tell them what had changed my life. She said she figured it was "religion or Jesus" but wanted to hear the rest of my story. She is lost and seeking. She is hurting but wasn't willing to put her trust in Christ. She said she worships the Greek goddess of the stars. That she talks to her every morning and when she does, her day goes better and she feels at peace. Pray for her. She is desperately seeking both Jesus and the truth.

Our goal is to use **creative tools** such as ventriloquism, illusions, drama, humorous illustrations, fire-eating, stunts with a 6-foot balloon and more to **challenge believers** to know and share Christ and to **reach people** who normally wouldn't come to church.

On future "tours", we also want to provide more conferences for evangelism, children's ministry



and youth ministry. We also want to do more door-to-door evangelism.

A Night on the Side of the Road

In our last newsletter we shared that we were at 35 days of repair on our brand new RV. Ford finally dropped a new engine in it and after two weeks of other repairs (including the car that ran into it while it was being repaired), we were up and running again. **It was in repair for 64 days!**

One week later, the battery light came on but the vehicle was still running. We made an appointment at the closest Ford dealership that could get us in quickly but it was 3 hours away. As we were driving it up the interstate, just after midnight, we began to lose power. **One by one our electrical systems when out until we were left on the side of the road with no ability to run.** This is not exactly the picture you have in mind when you sell your house and buy a new RV in which to live and travel.

Mary Beth told me that in the back, she began to pray that the Lord would just let us make it to the dealership but that the Lord wouldn't let her ask for this. Then she started to pray that the Lord would help us make it 20 miles up the road to a rest stop but again the Lord wouldn't let her. A third time, she tried to pray that the Lord would simply let us make it to the next exit, two miles up the road, but once more she felt the Lord wouldn't let her pray for this either. So she committed us into His hands and simply prayed that He would take us where we needed to go.

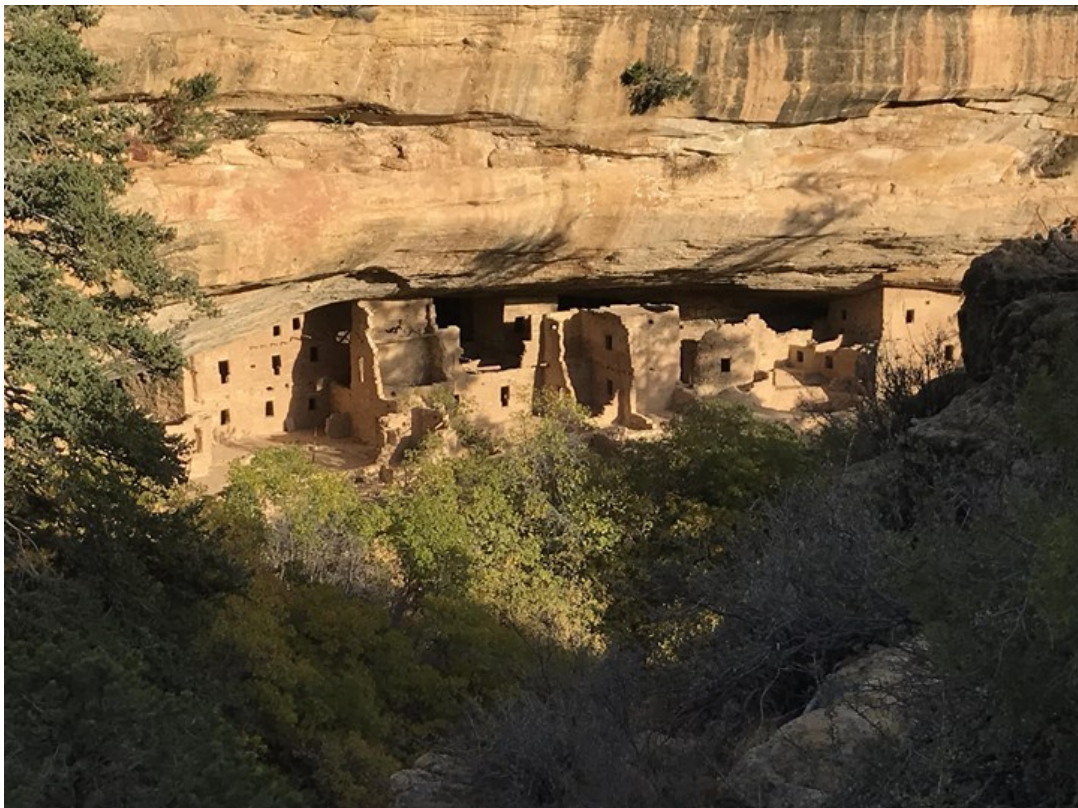
In the front, I sat in the driver's seat, waiting for the tow truck, feeling semi trucks

zipping past us at 75mph, only a few feet away. I asked the Lord to protect my family, to put a hand between us and the traffic. **I told the Lord that I didn't know what to do**--We were supposed to be in New Mexico in a couple of days. Our entire trip depended on us having the RV. Suddenly **I felt an amazing peace** that everything was okay.

The tow truck came around 5am and took us to the nearest repair place where they found the problem within an hour and by noon we were back on the road, headed to New Mexico. A cable from the battery had been damaged, perhaps when the new engine was put in. It was a fast repair. I don't know why this happened, but as I shared in the last newsletter, **we don't need all the answers to simply keep trusting**. I shared my testimony with one of the repair men and perhaps that is why the Lord gave us this detour--We won't know until eternity.

That was six weeks ago and although we still have some repairs scheduled for the end of November, being in the RV has opened the door for us to share the Gospel with greater freedom to travel and greater affordability for the churches with whom we've share.

It has been a unique experience that has **strengthened our trust** and challenged us to know that **our complete security is found in Christ**.
