Different Kinds of Love

Ask how many of your students love chocolate chip cookies. How many have a dog that they love? Who loves their parents? Tell your students that you love cookies (or some other favorite food), you love your dog, you love your spouse and you love God. But you love chocolate chip cookies in a different way than you love God. You love your spouse in a different way than you love your dog. The same word—different kinds of love.

Spiritual Application: But God wants you to love Him with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength. Then discuss the greatest commandment with your students—See Mark 12:30, Luke 10:27, Matthew 22:37, and Deuteronomy 6:5.
