Game: How Much Do You Love It Discussion: Love God above all things

Scripture : Luke 10:27

YOU WILL NEED: The signs on the following pages folded over so that the students can see the number but not "the prize" that is on the backside. Of course, be sure to tell your kids that this is just for fun and that the really don't get the "prizes."

How Much Do You Love It

Choose five volunteers—one at a time, ask each volunteer to choose a number between one and five. Whatever they choose, that's their prize. Of course, this is just for fun, so we actually have no prizes for you, not even a nice parting gift, but at least we'll have some fun. (Or, you can give each a piece of candy as a parting gift.) As each volunteer chooses a number, read everyone their prize from the back of the card and ask the volunteer on a scale of 1 to 10, how much they would love that items. For instance, the person who chooses the "glob of mud" (unless it's a boy) will probably say a "1" because there's not much love out there for a glob of mud.

After each has had a turn, ask them to sit down.

Read Luke 10:27 from your Bible

Explain to your students that there are a lot of things in life that we love and there's nothing wrong with that. Someone might even love a glob of mud, but we should never love anything more than we love the Lord.
