



## Sticky Situations

Buy several large containers of syrup. Cut the tops off so that a student's arm can fit down in it. Use a straw to push a large marshmallow to the bottom of the container. Choose a volunteer for each of the syrup containers. While holding the bag of marshmallows in your hand, tell them that there is a marshmallow at the bottom of each container and the first person to chew and swallow a marshmallow will be the winner. Ready, set, go! It's important that you use these words in order to make the point below.

Spiritual Application: James 4:2—You have not because you ask not. You didn't have to stick your arm down in that syrup or get yourself into a sticky situation trying to work things out on your own. All you had to do was ask for a marshmallow. I had them right here in my hand, but you have not because you ask not. The same in true with prayer...
